Glogster Criteria

Title:

- Creative and informs the reader of the main idea of the poster

Required Multimedia Elements:

- Wallpaper:
 - Provides an interesting background for the information you plan to share
- Text:
 - Written explanations bring all other media together to deliver information
- Graphics & Images:
 - Photos, drawings, graphs, etc.
 - Visual enhancements promote interest
- Sound:
 - Stimulates imagination
 - Highlights the content
 - Can be stopped, started, and reviewed easily
 - Reaches auditory learners
- Video:
 - Stimulates more interest than printed materials
 - Brings information to students such as distant places and past events
 - Can be stopped, started and rewound to review or make predictions
 - Short, relevant clips keep students interested
 - Reaches visual and auditory learners

Required Informational Elements:

- Share information from the Notetaking Guide
 - Where did the event occur?
 - To what extent does geography impact the genocide?
 - Who did it affect?
 - Why did this happen?
 - When did it occur?
 - What happened? Explain the conflict
 - World Response
 - Did any country around the world (especially the U.S.) know the event was occurring?
 - What, if anything, did they do to help?
 - Personal Reflection
 - Develop a statement or phrase that expresses your thoughts about genocide and the world's response to it.

Content:

- The content is accurate and tells a complete story

Attractiveness

- Multimedia elements and content combine to deliver a high impact message

Mechanics & Grammar

- Capitalization and punctuation & grammar are correct throughout the poster

Attractiveness	Multimedia elements and content combine to deliver a high impact message with the elements and words reinforcing each other 4 Points	Multimedia elements accompany content but there is some tendency toward random use of graphical elements that do not reinforce message 2 Points	Exaggerated emphasis on graphics and special effects weakens the message and interferes with the communication of content and ideas 1 Point
Mechanics & Grammar	Capitalization and punctuation are correct throughout the poster; no grammatical mistakes 3 Points	There is 1 error in capitalization, punctuation or grammar 2 Points	There are 2 or more errors in capitalization, punctuation or grammar 1Point
