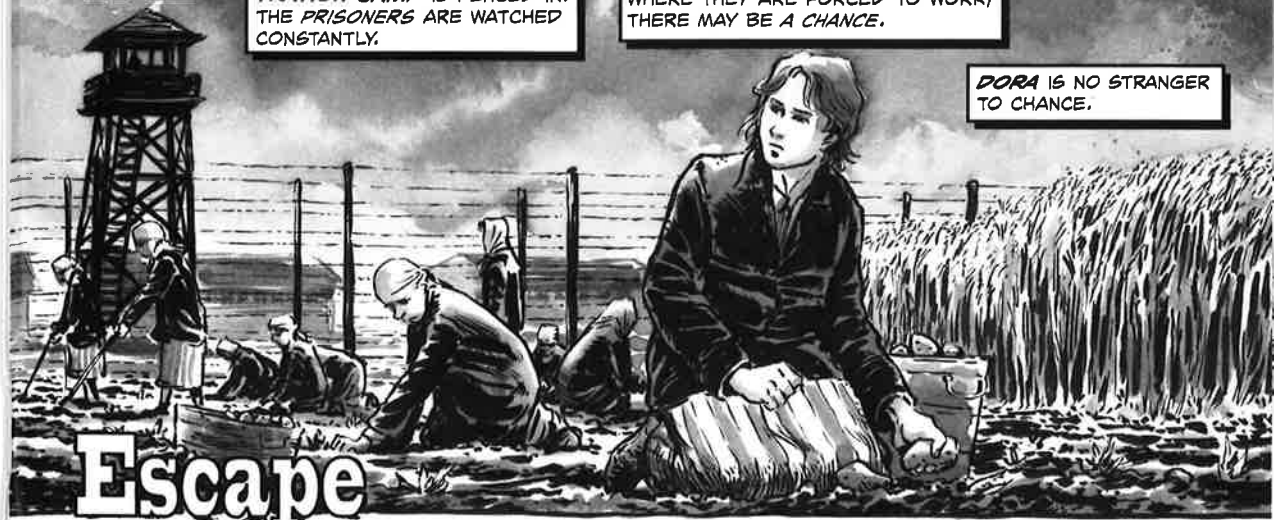

THE JANOWSKA CONCENTRATION CAMP IS FENCED IN. THE PRISONERS ARE WATCHED CONSTANTLY.

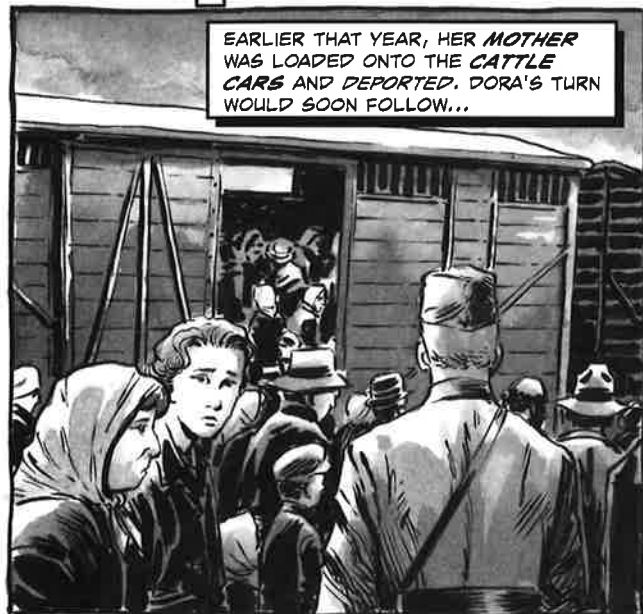
BUT OUT HERE, IN THE FIELDS WHERE THEY ARE FORCED TO WORK, THERE MAY BE A CHANCE.

DORA IS NO STRANGER TO CHANCE.

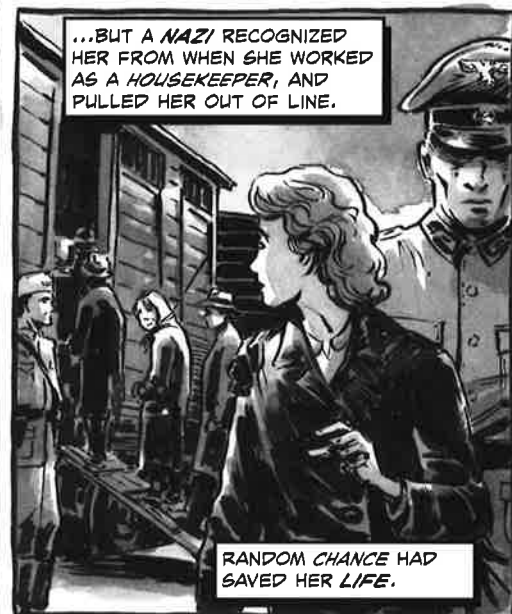


## Escape
